

TRISTAR BOYS F.C- HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

Introduction

The welfare of members is paramount to Tristar Boys F.C and therefore we will expect Health and Safety practises and guidelines to be adhered to. There is an obligation on members, and in particular management, to implement measures that will minimise the likelihood of personal injury during club activities. Amendments to safety practises will require the approval of the Management Committee.

Guidelines

We aim to pursue this policy through the following guidelines:

- 1) Purchasing safe and reliable equipment with regular maintenance.
- 2) Familiarising membership with First Aid Procedures together with the content and location of First Aid Kits.
- 3) Ensuring that activity clothing is appropriate.
- 4) Providing information to coaches and volunteers regarding procedures for recording accidents.
- 5) Ensuring that there is adequate insurance cover for club activities.
- 6) Induction training for coaches relating to basic Health and Safety requirements including fire drill procedures, location of fire exits, fire extinguishers, etc...
- 7) Ensuring proper hygiene conditions during club activities.
- 8) Appropriate volunteer / member ratios.
- 9) Ensuring proper supervision during travel and that transport insurance is in place
- 10) Ensuring proper supervision during training sessions and matches

Responsibility

Whilst Management Committee have primary responsible for Health and Safety practices, there is also a duty on membership to exercise responsibility to prevent personal injury or injury to others.

REVIEW

The Health and Safety Policy and Practices will be reviewed annually by Management in conjunction with coaches and volunteers.
